

## **SPORTS PREMIUM**

We are in the very lucky position that we have staff who are both knowledgeable and enthusiastic about the various activities that are taught in our PE lessons. In previous years they have received training which the children continue to benefit from. In addition we have a specialist P.E. teacher who is willing and able to share her expertise when necessary.

We are also well resourced thanks to the whole school community collecting Active Kids vouchers which we have been able to spend on new equipment.

The Government allocated this premium with specific objectives:

- To improve the quality of existing PE teaching
- To increase participation
- To promote PE specialism in the primary level workforce
- To help schools understand and value the benefits of PE and sport

Historically, Gosden House has used the premium to pay for outside providers who, whilst teaching the classes, have been giving the teachers and TA;s new subject knowledge.

It has also paid for the training of TA's in PE related courses.

We are able to book a workshop that encouraged mass participation and educated children on the benefits of an active lifestyle.

We were able to purchase medals to reward children for their achievements.

The remainder of the money will be going towards the cost of resurfacing the tennis court area. This will give us an excellent enclosed facility that can be used for numerous activities both in lessons and during break times.
