

# SERVICES

As part of the Surrey Inclusion Outreach Service, Gosden Outreach works with Surrey mainstream schools to support inclusion for students with learning & additional needs (LAN).



Gosden Outreach offers service in “Blocks”. This means we spend 1-2 hours each week at your school over the course of a half-term. The visits are planned at the initial visit with your SENCO and each will be planned to fit with your schedule. A wide range of trainings are also available at no additional cost.

## CHILD FOCUS

- Observation reports to establish a baseline
- Provide specific recommendations and strategies that staff can implement
- Behaviour plans, target setting, visual supports and teaching strategies
- Generalising support in a school-wide context
- Modelling strategies and support for specific pupils

## GROUP OF STUDENTS

- Address learning supports for a specific teaching and learning need in your school
- Modelling and generalising best-practice strategies for students with learning difficulties

## TRAINING & DEVELOPMENT

- INSET and training for teaching pupils with **LAN, dyslexia (reading & writing), dyscalculia, communication and behavioural needs**

Plan, Do Review

**Referral:** Your school SENCO makes a referral for Outreach Support by either **calling us** or sending in a **referral form** via **email**. Your referral can be for specific student needs, inclusive practice support, staff training, or a unique need.

**Respond:** We aim to respond to your Outreach Support Referral within 5 working days. We will do this via phone call, email or by visiting your school to discuss the type of support you would like.

**Review (Plan, Do, Review):** Together we develop a plan of action for how we can support your LAN students. We also kindly ask that you evaluate our service once we have completed our service.
