



We are in the very lucky position that we have staff who are both knowledgeable and enthusiastic about the various activities that are taught in our PE lessons. In previous years they have received training which the children continue to benefit from. In addition we have a specialist PE teacher who is willing and able to share her expertise when necessary.

The Government allocated this premium with specific objectives:

These outside providers have allowed us to offer the students new and exciting activities.

It has also paid for two members of staff to train as lifeguards.

We were able to purchase medals to reward students for these achievements in competitive sports.

It was used to help pay travel costs to various events that either allowed students to experience new activities or enter competitions.

The remainder of the money will be going towards the cost of resurfacing and equipping the netted area. This has given us an excellent enclosed facility that is used for numerous activities both in lessons and at break times.
