

## **Year 7 Catch-up Funding STATEMENT 2018–19**

The literacy and numeracy Catch-up Premium is a government allocation which gives schools additional funding to support pupils in Year 7 who did not achieve the expected standard in reading or maths at the end of Key Stage 2 (KS2). The funding is used to provide literacy and numeracy support to enable pupils to 'catch-up' as quickly as possible in order to provide maximum opportunity to succeed at secondary school.

We identified the pupils who needed the extra support and have allocated this funding to provide personalised individual and small group support in Literacy and Numeracy.

Literacy: Precision teaching, RWInc, Clicker 7, IXL online programme.

Numeracy: Numicon resources and IXL online programme.

## **Objectives of the Catch-up Funding**

- To close the gap in attainment of pupils eligible for 'catch-up' premium by providing intensive support in literacy and numeracy.
- To accelerate progress through appropriate intervention.
- To raise the self-confidence and resilience of our pupils who are entitled to 'catch-up' premium.
