



2020-2021 Primary Sports Premium Grant

PE is headed by a specialist teacher and the subject is tracked through a Development Plan. Pupils continue to enjoy competing and trying new sports and taking part in events

Unfortunately Judo, swimming, RDA and yoga had to be paused part way through the year during Covid but we hope to re-introduce them when it is considered safe to do so.

We received a total annual allocation of £16,000. We have a carry forward to continue to develop skills within the school.

We have the challenge of impacting a wide range of ages, physical abilities and Special Educational Needs and this year, the additional challenges of safely educating children during a global pandemic. We remained open to a large proportion of our children throughout the year, including during national school shutdowns and during some school holidays, to enable vulnerable children and those whose parents/carers key-workers to attend school.
