

## 2021-2022 Primary Sports Premium Grant

PE is headed by a specialist teacher and the subject is tracked through a Development Plan. Pupils continue to enjoy competing and trying new sports and taking part in events

Unfortunately Judo, RDA and yoga remained paused due to Covid but we were able to re-introduce swimming (only top-up swimming was funded via this Grant with ore swimming continuing to be funded via general school funds).

We received a total annual allocation of £16,500 and carried forward £700.

We have the challenge of impacting a wide range of ages, physical abilities and Special Educational Needs and this year, the additional challenges of safely educating children during a global pandemic continued. We remained open to a large proportion of our children throughout the year, including during national school shutdowns, to enable vulnerable children and those whose parents/carers key-workers to attend school.
